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Subject: Adoption of the FY 2021-22 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties Resolution G-21-58

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties as provided in Attachment B, and direct staff to transmit the list of eligible jurisdictions to the State Controller (Controller).

Issue:

The Commission must submit the adopted Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties to the Controller on or by August 31, 2021. Eligible cities and counties will begin receiving monthly disbursements from the Controller in September 2021.

For jurisdictions to be included in the Fiscal Year 2021-22 initial eligibility report, jurisdictions must adopt, by resolution, a list of projects expected to be funded with the fiscal year program funds for which eligibility is sought. The list and resolution must be adopted by a city or county and received by the Commission no later than July 1, 2021.

Statute and the 2021 Local Streets and Road Funding Program Guidelines require each project on a city or county's list include a project description, location detail, useful life, and schedule.

Cities and counties are estimated to receive approximately \$1.2 billion in Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funds through monthly disbursements from the Controller in Fiscal Year 2021-22.

By July 1, 2021, 519 out of 539 jurisdictions submitted the required resolution and project list detail to the Commission. The 519 jurisdictions (463 cities and 56 counties) deemed eligible for funding are identified in the Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties (Attachment B).

Commission staff have confirmed that all other remaining cities and counties intend to seek subsequent funding eligibility by September 2021. For a period of 90-days, the Controller will retain apportionment amounts for the remaining 18 cities and 2 counties. Commission staff will continue to work with these cities and counties to ensure timely and complete submittals for subsequent eligibility (Attachment B).

Complete submittals received after the initial July 1, 2021 deadline, but on or before September 30, 2021, will be brought forward for adoption at the October 2021 Commission meeting. Those submittals received after September 30, 2021 will not be included in the subsequent eligibility list for Fiscal Year 2021-22, and therefore those jurisdictions will not begin receiving monthly disbursements for the fiscal year. The Controller will recalculate and disburse those funds forfeited by existing formula, amongst those jurisdictions that have been deemed eligible for Fiscal Year 2021-22 funding.

Background:

On April 28, 2017, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017). A percentage of the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funding created by SB 1 is apportioned by formula and disbursed monthly by the Controller's Office to eligible cities and counties pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2032(h) for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on the local streets and roads system.

Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2034, for jurisdictions to be included in the initial eligibility report presented to the Commission for consideration, a list of projects adopted by resolution must be submitted to the Commission, each year.

In March 2021, the Commission adopted the 2021 Local Streets and Roads Funding Program Reporting Guidelines to amend the 2019 Local Streets and Roads Funding Program Reporting Guidelines. Amendments made to the guidelines provided technical clarification for program terms and processes already in practice, provide clarification on the program's eligibility requirements, and modify the program's reporting schedule.

Cities and counties that receive fiscal year program funds are required to submit an expenditure report to the Commission each year. Fiscal Year 2020-21 Expenditure Reports are due to the Commission by December 1, 2021, to account for all program funds received and spent in the fiscal year.

RESOLUTION G-21-58

- 1.1 **WHEREAS**, on April 28, 2017, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on both the state highway and local streets and road system; and
- 1.2 **WHEREAS**, beginning November 1, 2017, portions of new funding from increases to certain fuel excise and sales taxes and vehicle registration fees were deposited into the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, and a percentage of this new funding is apportioned monthly by formula by the State Controller pursuant to paragraph (2) of subdivision (h) of Section 2032 of the Streets and Highways Code to eligible cities and counties for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on local streets and roads; and
- 1.3 **WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1) requires that prior to receiving an apportionment of Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funds pursuant to paragraph (2) of subdivision (h) of Section 2032 from the Controller in a fiscal year, an eligible city or county shall submit to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) a list of projects proposed to be funded with these funds pursuant to an adopted resolution; and
- 1.4 **WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2) requires that the Commission report to the State Controller the cities and counties that have submitted a list of projects as described in this subdivision and that are therefore eligible to receive an apportionment of funds under the program for the applicable fiscal year. The State Controller, upon receipt of the report, shall apportion funds to eligible cities and counties; and
- 1.5 **WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1) specifies that the project list shall not limit the flexibility of an eligible city or county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with Streets and Highways Code Section 2030(b); and

- 1.6 **WHEREAS**, the Commission, in consultation with cities, counties, and their representatives as well as the State Controller's Office and other stakeholders, developed the 2021 Local Streets and Roads Funding Program Annual Reporting Guidelines adopted by the Commission on March 24, 2021, revising the detail and process for the project list submittal and project expenditure reporting; and
- 1.7 **WHEREAS**, Commission staff collected the Fiscal Year 2021-22 project list resolution submittals from cities and counties as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1); and
- 1.8 **WHEREAS**, While Commission staff (pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1)) reviewed submittals for completeness, Commission staff did not select or authorize the projects listed; and
- 1.9 **WHEREAS**, Commission staff compiled a list of cities and counties that provided complete project list resolution submittals and are therefore eligible to receive Fiscal Year 2021-22 formula apportionments of Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding, as reflected in the attached Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties; and
- 1.10 **WHEREAS**, that attachment is intended to serve as the initial report of eligible cities and counties as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2), for transmittal to the State Controller.
- 2.1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Commission adopts the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties; and
- 2.2 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Commission staff is authorized to make minor technical changes as needed to the report; and
- 2.3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Commission directs staff to transmit the report to the State Controller as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2).
